1. CALL TO ORDER

Chancellor King called the Zoom Conference meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS

The April 6 meeting agenda and minutes of the March 30, 2020 meeting were approved by consensus.

3. FALL 2020 COURSE SCHEDULE

LRCFT President Dean Murakami and Academic Senate President Julie Oliver shared some of the feedback they have received regarding the decision to build the Fall schedule with a typical mixture of on-ground, online and hybrid classes, with the notable difference that we will clearly communicate to students that all classes will require the use of Canvas. They said the feedback has been supportive and expressed appreciation for being able to work collaboratively to come to an agreement. Deputy Chancellor Jamey Nye noted there have already been continuing conversations with LRCFT on some issues that will need to be worked out prior to implementation.

4. COVID-19 UPDATES

Chancellor King shared that a Digital Equity Group has been formed and will be led by Associate Vice Chancellors Tamara Armstrong, Melanie Dixon, and Paula Allison. Some of the student needs are very expensive and it will be a challenge to respond to amid the potential budget reductions. The group will work to figure out how to support the gaps that exist in a way that is sustainable by seeking outside partners and donor support. Sadly, there are many more student needs than we can meet, so we'll need to be strategic about prioritizing and rationing the resources in order to not run out in the short term. There will be constituency engagement and involvement as the plan is developed.

Vice Chancellor Mario Rodriguez provided an update on the budget based on conversations he has had with legislative staff and the Department of Finance. Given that the tax deadlines have been extended, the May Revise will be a shot in the dark because we won't have those April 15 receipts. Chancellor King added that the immediate relief in the federal stimulus funding enabled the district to continue to pay all temporary classified and student workers through the end of the semester.

The next Chancellor's Cabinet meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 13.
