#### **1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chancellor King called the Zoom Conference meeting to order at 2:32 p.m.

#### **2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS**

The April 13 meeting agenda and minutes of the April 6, 2020 meeting were approved by consensus.

#### **3. COVID-19 UPDATES**

Chancellor King went through a list of some of the District's significant accomplishments over the last few weeks as an opportunity to celebrate everyone's hard work. Faculty leaders Julie Oliver and Jason Newman said they were impressed with all of our faculty who have really stepped up during this transition, and proud of the new agreement reached with the District for the fall semester. The college presidents each echoed the sentiments of appreciating the hard work and dedication that has gone into transitioning to being fully remote, as well as the team effort that has gone into supporting our community when it came to providing medical supplies, PPE, etc. where needed. CRC Classified Senate President Julie Olsen recognized that classified employees are remaining engaged and focused on the big picture of student success.

Vice Chancellor Mario Rodriguez provided an update on the budget developments since the last meeting. A letter from the Department of Finance and a memo from the State Chancellor's Office providing an update on the CARES Act Federal Stimulus Package allocations was emailed to Chancellor's Cabinet members before the meeting. One of the things noted in the memo was that the unemployment rate could be higher than in the Great Recession. Vice Chancellor Rodriguez said that hopefully the difficult planning we're doing now will help us be more prepared for the May Revise, and we'll need to program these dollars appropriately so that we're also prepared for the continuing impact.

It was noted that the meeting would be adjourning in time for the faculty leaders to participate in a 3pm conference call with the State Chancellor's Office and the Statewide Academic Senate regarding the Distance Education Addendum.
