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#### **1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chancellor King called the Zoom Conference meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

#### **2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS**

The May 10, 2021 meeting agenda, as well as the April 12, 2021 (revised with appendix) and April 26, 2021 minutes, were approved.

#### **3. PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO BOARD POLICY 7241, GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

General Counsel Jake Knapp presented the proposed revisions to Board Policy 7241. With the Chancellor's Cabinet approval, this will be brought to the Board of Trustees next.

#### **4. PROPOSED PROCESS TO REAFFIRM THE STRATEGIC PLAN**

The time has come to reaffirm the framework of the goals outlined in the District's Strategic Plan and Chancellor's Cabinet serves as the steering committee for the Strategic Plan. Academic Senate President Julie Oliver provided an overview of the draft process that she developed with CRC President Ed Bush, which would entail creating more of a living document that is reviewed and refreshed by Chancellor's Cabinet annually rather than every few years.

#### **5. DEBRIEF OF MAY 6 LOS RIOS SUMMIT FOR THE FUTURE**

Chancellor King began this discussion by thanking the classified leaders who provided feedback and helped inform the presentation prior to the Summit. The college presidents and other representatives reported on the various opportunities they have had for their campus communities to debrief after the Summit and share additional questions and feedback. Members of Chancellor's Cabinet shared some of the feedback they have received from their constituents, as well as their own opinions of the pros and cons of the Summit format. Chancellor King emphasized that the Summit was the first of many conversations to come about the process of reimagining services for our students.

Chancellor's Cabinet meetings will pause for the summer and resume at the beginning of the Fall 2021 semester unless a need for a mid-summer update is needed.
